Congratulations to Dr. Camilla Vigato, Dr. Anda Cristina Pulcar, and Dr. Alessia Filippa from UNITO for graduating from the master's degree programs in Clinical, Forensic, and Sport Chemistry; Food Science and Human Nutrition; and Food Science and Technology, respectively.

All three students successfully completed their programs with the highest marks (110/110), with Dr. Filippa earning cum laude distinction. Their final papers were titled:

"Targeted/Non-targeted Analysis of Plant Metabolites in Tomatoes Grown with Different Fertilizers"

"Biofertilizing Effect of Insect Fronds and Pollen on Fruit Quality of Tomato (*Solanum lycopersicum* L.)"

"Use of Live Larvae of *Tenebrio molitor* in the Feeding of dual-purpose local species Bionda Piemontese: Effects on Egg Quality"

These papers present original analyses conducted on experimental tomato samples collected in the summer of 2023 as part of an open-field trial organized by CNR ISPA colleagues, as well as on larvae and eggs collected during the experimental trial at the Tetto Frati Experimental Facility in Carmagnola (TO).
